MICHAEL EDWARD DUNN, being first duly sworn, deposes and says: That I was born in Lebanon, Wisconsin, United States of America, on the 1st day of July, 1875, and was married to Matilda Cecilie Lalonde on the 2nd day of September, 1913, who was born in Tomahawk, Wisconsin, on June 6, 1890. That after our marriage we moved to Canada on the 16th day of April, 1913, where we made our home and where we were residing at the time of the birth of our son James William Dunn, at Saskatoon, Sask., Canada, on October 17, 1914.

That at the time of the birth of our said son my wife and I were both citizens of the United States of America; that I was not a naturalized Canadian citizen at the time of his said birth; that I became a naturalized Canadian citizen on August 18, 1931, through Certificate No. 81048, Series A, issued to me by the Department of the Secretary of Canada.

That according to Section 1993, Act of Congress of April 4, 1802, amended on February 10, 1885, and on May 24, 1934, my son is entitled to declare himself a citizen of the United States of America, because he was born prior to my naturalization as a citizen of Canada, and while I was still a citizen of the United States of America, and I am making this affidavit on his behalf in order that he may so declare himself and become eligible to join the Armed Forces of the United States.
